- treat all students fairly and respectfully

- report any safeguarding concerns immediately.

5. Reporting Concerns

If any safeguarding concerns arise during tutoring sessions, they should be reported to DeltaCurve Tutoring immediately.

Appropriate steps will then be taken to address the concern.
